**UKRAINIAN SOVIET GOVERNMENT
IN EMIGRATION IN 1919**

In the paper on the basis of little-known archival materials of the Russian Federation the issue of staying in Moscow and other cities of Soviet Russia the government of the USSR in the autumn of 1919 after the capture of Ukraine by the whites is studied. The process of elimination of the evacuated Ukrainian central and local institutions (September–November) is specified, the names of the participants of the events are described.
