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**CURRENT ISSUES OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND LEGAL PROVISION OF
AN INTERACTION OF THE INSTITUTIONS OF CIVIL SOCIETY WITH
BODIES AND UNITS OF THE NATIONAL POLICE OF UKRAINE**

Paper deals with the issues of the administrative and legal provision of an interaction of civil society institutions with the bodies and units of the National Police of Ukraine. It is noted that the National Police interact with the public through the preparation and implementation of joint projects, programs and measures to meet the needs of the population and improve the efficiency of the tasks assigned to it. The cooperation between the National Police and the public is aimed at identification and address of the issues associated with the implementation of police activities and promotion of the use of modern methods to increase the effectiveness and efficiency of such activities. Deepening of the partnership between the police and the public is a powerful factor in the development of the rule of law and the assertion of civil society. The direction of an improvement of this socio-legal institute is the normative consolidation of new forms of interaction between the police and the citizens.

Consequently, we can conclude that today there is a pressing need for the adoption of new normative legal acts of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine, the Department of National Police of Ukraine, which would regulate the peculiarities of the interaction of law enforcement bodies and the population. It is necessary to prepare methodological recommendations on the subject and procedure of conducting classes with public assistants of police inspectors, to develop a mechanism for involving non-members of law-enforcement activities in public formations. In view of the above mentioned, the following conclusions can be drawn: the organization of police activities, based on its public support and aimed at preventing crimes and offenses, is fully in line with today's conditions, and the improvement of the interaction of police with the population is a prerequisite for the trust of citizens in law enforcement, as well as to power in general; analysis and use of foreign experience of the participation of the population in law enforcement activities is an effective tool for a qualitative improvement of cooperation between the police and the public, a real opportunity to increase the efficiency of the police work; implementation of the models of police activity of foreign countries into the work of law enforcement agencies by use of the consultative mechanism and cooperation with the population in the protection of public order has become nowadays an urgent need; in addition, there is a need for the development and adoption of normative documents that would regulate this aspect of law-enforcement activity at both the state and sectoral levels.
