THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared a pandemic of coronavirus infection SARS-CoV-2. On March 12, 2020, quarantine was introduced in Ukraine in connection with the need to prevent the spread of coronavirus COVID-

19 in Ukraine, which significantly limited human life. Once at home, the population, mostly women and children, experienced an increase in domestic violence. A similar situation is observed in a number of other countries. The article presents data on the increase in the number of cases of domestic violence during the COVID-19 pandemic in Ukraine, France, Spain, Brazil, Australia, Canada, and the United Kingdom. The international experience of preventing and combating domestic violence during the COVID-19 pandemic is studied. Describes the measures taken by Ukraine as a result of the need to respond quickly to the increasing number of cases of domestic violence, as well as measures to prevent and combat domestic violence taken by other countries on the example of Italy, France, Portugal, Spain, Ireland, UK, Poland, Denmark, Czech Republic and the United States. Based on the above material, conclusions are given on the need to implement additional measures to prevent and combat domestic violence in Ukraine, for example, the allocation of additional premises for temporary housing for victims of domestic violence; active involvement and training of local government representatives in their role in combating domestic violence on the ground; ensuring the proper functioning of the Unified State Register of Cases of Domestic Violence and Gender-Based Violence. In addition, it was concluded that it is necessary to develop an application for mobile phones with a hidden function of access to the police, geolocation and hidden recording of photos, audio and video, then stored in the Internet cloud or sent by e-mail to further use the information as evidence of domestic violence.
