**LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES OF UKRAINE: FROM
THE DECLARATION OF STATE INDEPENDENCE TO THE REVOLUTION
OF DIGNITY (AUGUST 24, 1991 – FEBRUARY 2014)
CHRONICLE OF KEY EVENTS**

This article highlights the main events in the formation of law enforcement agencies of Ukraine, from the proclamation of independence to the Revolution of Dignity (August 24, 1991 – February 2014). In particular, the authors note that the extraordinary session of the Supreme Soviet of the Ukrainian SSR of the twentieth convocation adopted the Act on the Declaration of Independence of Ukraine and

resolutions on the political situation in Ukraine and the immediate actions of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine to create conditions for not a further military coup; on department of state bodies, institutions and organizations; on military formations in Ukraine; the Law of the Ukrainian SSR on granting additional powers to the Chairman of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine. Since that time, new stage in the life of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine begins – as a department of a sovereign state. Moreover, the Ministry of Internal Affairs issued order No. 383 “On revision of departmental normative acts and creation of normative base of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine”, under which the heads of main departments, directorates, independent divisions of the Ministry were ordered to review all departmental normative documents and cancel those of them, which lost their practical importance or contradicted the current legislation of Ukraine, in the established order; issued the Decree of the Presidium of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine “On subordination to Ukraine of the internal troops stationed on its territory”, the order of the USSR Interior Ministry on department of internal affairs bodies and internal troops of the USSR. The Ministers of Internal Affairs of the Union republics were instructed to “prevent and suppress harassment, persecution and other forms of discrimination against employees of internal affairs bodies and servicemen of internal troops for their affiliation with political parties and movements and political convictions, as well as for exercising their constitutional right to participate in political activities outside the internal affairs bodies, units and formations of internal troops and outside their service time”; there was issued the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 197 “On the procedure for compensation to the rank and file of the internal affairs bodies for the service beyond the statutory working hours, as well as in the days of weekly rest and holidays”; the order of the Interior Ministry of Ukraine on the approval and enactment of the Instructions “On the reception, registration, accounting and consideration in the bodies, units and institutions of the Interior of Ukraine statements, reports and other information about crimes”; the order of the Chairman of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine “On the Establishment of the Internal and Convoy Service Troops in the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine” was issued, etc. Publication of this regulatory framework was motivated primarily by the proclamation of Ukraine’s independence, and as a result, by the need to bring existing legislation in the Ukrainian SSR in line with new requirements.
